We also have a list of hotlines that provide **all-options counseling**. You can call these services to get information about pregnancy decisions and all options (birth, adoption, abortion)- without judgment, just facts.

ABORTION is SAFE!



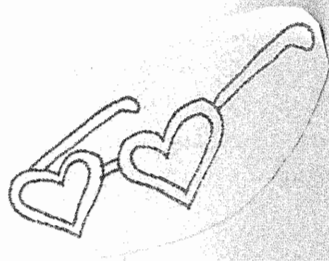
Abortion is 14 times safer than childbirth

- Physician Assistants

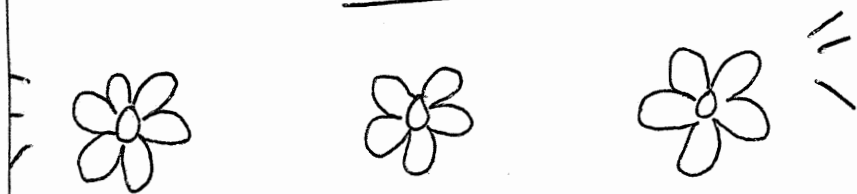

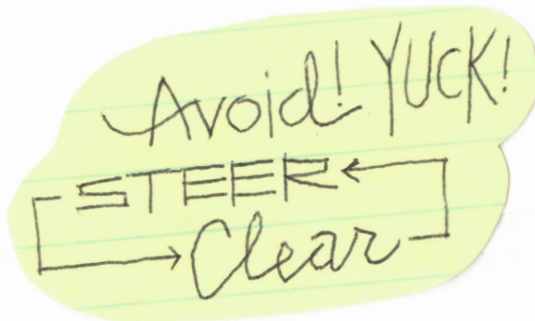
What is a **Crisis Pregnancy Center (CPC) a.k.a. Fake Clinic?**

- **Faith-based** fake clinics that rely heavily on **lying to pregnant people** about reproductive health care in order to **keep them from having abortions**. They outnumber real health clinics.
- Fake clinics usually “offer free pregnancy tests or other services to lure women into their offices.”¹
- These fake clinics open up storefronts that use **false and misleading** advertising and **propaganda** about abortions.

- Fake clinics often pretend to be real health clinics by looking like a doctor's office, even though they are **not medical professionals**.



Beware!

Fake clinics use Facebook, Google and Google Maps to advertise!

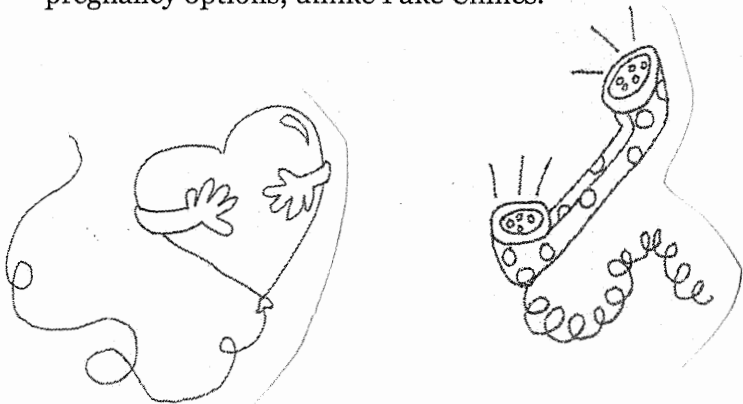
Fake clinics use online advertising and search engine optimization techniques via Facebook, Google Maps, and other apps and sites to trick pregnant people into using them instead of real health clinics.

Searching for “abortion,” “morning-after pill,” “women’s health clinics” and other pregnancy search terms online can lead to lies paid for by Fake Clinics.²

2. Call one of the hotlines we recommend in this zine. These provide reliable, accurate counseling on all pregnancy options, unlike Fake Clinics.

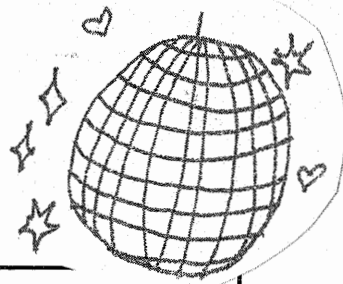

What is an abortion fund?

Abortion fund: an organization that works to remove financial and logistical barriers to abortion access. Some of them help pay for your abortion. Some offer transportation, childcare, translation, doula services, and places to stay if you have to travel to get your abortion.



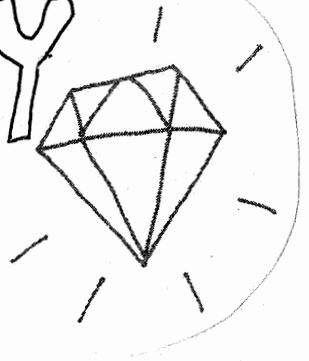

GLOSSARY



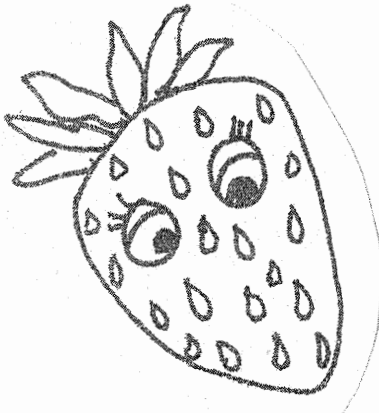
All-options counseling: Facts about all of your options (adoption, abortion, birth) regarding your individual pregnancy, provided by a medical professional without judgment or shame.

Family-Planning Clinic: A clinic that provides advice and treatment relating to your sexual health (includes birth control).

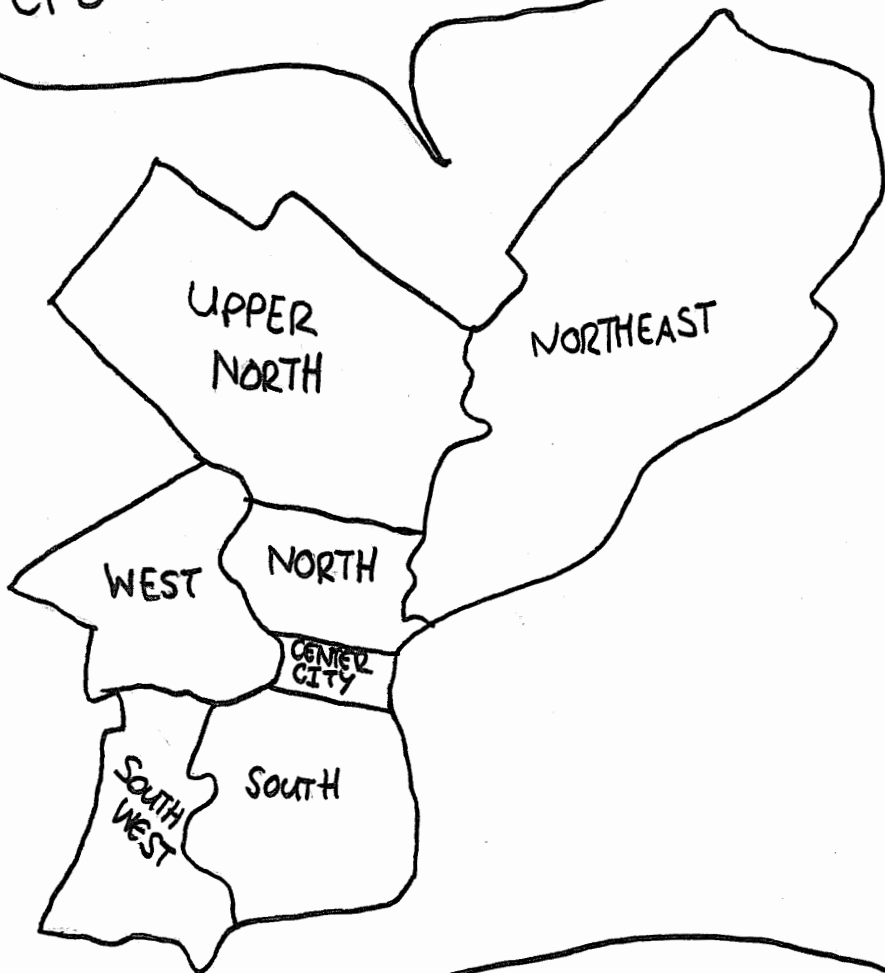
Doula: People who have special (non-medical) training to assist a pregnant person and their family with birth, adoption, and abortion. They give physical, emotional, and informational support.

OB/GYN: Doctors that works with pregnant people, with women, and with people who can become pregnant.

Infertility: Experience of not getting or staying pregnant even though you are having unprotected sex.
